What better way is there to off set the high cost of heating your home than to burn firewood? We collect a lot of wood during the year through trimming and removing trees. All the wood we keep is the cream of the crop: Ash, locust, maple, Aspen, Ailanthus, linden, etc. with some pine here and there. We sell the wood in 2 forms; split and bulk.

Our bulk wood is random lengths of logs that people load and haul off themselves. Price for the bulk wood is \$50.00 a pickup truck load. Split wood is \$90.00 for a half cord, \$160.00 per full cord, you load and haul it away. We can also deliver and dump split wood it for \$60.00 (1/2 or full cord) within a 6 mile radius of our shop. Stock up today and sit next to a cozy warm fire tonight!
